

Inaugural Manitowoc County DHIA Scholarship

The Manitowoc County DHIA scholarship funds are the accumulation of remaining funds after the consolidation of Manitowoc DHIA and Eastern Wisconsin DHIC. This is a limited lifetime scholarship with a sunset of 15 years.

There are five \$500 scholarships available. Any Manitowoc County resident or resident of the nearby area is eligible. The applicant **MUST** be pursuing an ag-related degree. Students can be currently enrolled or planning to attend any college or university (technical, short course or 4 year degree).

Students can be entering any year of college. However, preference will be given to previous non-recipients.

The completed application (including signature) and three letters of reference must be postmarked by March 1st, 2010. Send all materials to:
