## Low-Interest Commodity Loans Are Available

The Farm Service Agency (FSA) has very low-interest nine-month commodity loans available to help producers in Manitowoc and Calumet Counties with operating expenses. After harvesting eligible 2017 crops, eligible producers may obtain a loan on the stored production using the crop as collateral for the loan. Loans provide short-term financing at very low interest rates while waiting to feed or market the commodity. The current interest rate is 2.25%.

Eligible crops include corn, oats, barley, wheat, soybeans and other oilseeds. Corn includes shelled corn, ear corn and high moisture corn as well as rolled, cracked or crimped corn. Processed corn is eligible as long as some kernels remain recognizable. Honey and wool are also eligible for loans.

The commodity must be stored in an acceptable structure on farm or in an approved warehouse or mill. Approved warehouses or mills are those that are State or Federally licensed and can issue a negotiable warehouse receipt for the stored commodity. Storage bags are also considered acceptable storage provided they are inspected by FSA prior to loan approval.

The deadline to obtain a loan on 2017-crop wheat, oats or barley is March 31, 2018 and the deadline for a loan on 2017-crop corn and soybeans is May 31, 2018.

Producers should allow at least two weeks for loan processing time. The Manitowoc FSA office administers commodity loans for both counties, so producers with questions should contact the Manitowoc office at 920-683-5119, ext. 2 with any questions.

## Producers Must Report Alfalfa, Wheat and Other Perennial Crop Acreages by November 15th

Producers are reminded that their 2018-crop report for alfalfa, winter wheat, other fall seeded grains and any other perennial crops must be filed by no later than **Wednesday, November 15th**. Acreage reports are required to establish eligibility for most FSA programs.

If you have not yet reported and do not have an appointment scheduled please contact your FSA office as soon as possible. Late-filed reports can be accepted after November 15th, but fees will apply. The Manitowoc office can be reached by calling 683-5119, ext. 2 and the Calumet office can be reached by calling 849-3570, ext. 2.



## USDA is Providing Emergency Loans to Calumet and Manitowoc County Farmers Due to Winterkill and Heavy Rains

USDA through the Farm Service Agency (FSA) is making emergency loans available to farmers in Calumet and Manitowoc counties who have suffered qualifying production losses based upon damages and losses caused by winterkill and freezing conditions that occurred between January 1, 2017 and May 26, 2017 or for losses and damages caused by heavy rains that occurred between June 14, 2017, and July 14, 2017.

Actual loss loans for production losses will be based upon the disaster year production compared to the previous three year production history.

Applications for losses due to winterkill must be submitted by February 28, 2018. Applications for losses due to the heavy rains must be submitted by May 29, 2018. Farmers who feel they have sustained a qualifying loss and desire more information should contact the Farm Loan Team at the Manitowoc FSA Office at 920-683-5119, ext. 2.

## Manitowoc County Farmers Protect Soil and Water Quality by Using Cover Crops

Manitowoc County farmers own and manage 230,735 acres, or 61%, of the county's land base. The practices they implement on their fields can greatly impact the surrounding environment. As stewards of the land, many farmers in Manitowoc County are utilizing practices that improve soil and water quality. One practice that has been gaining momentum with farmers in the county is planting cover crops.

### *What is a Cover Crop?*

A cover crop is a type of crop farmers grow in between their usual planting sequence to improve soil and water quality. Legumes such as clover, and grasses such as rye, are mainly used as cover crops. There are a number of different crops that can be planted as a cover crop depending on the farmer's goals and needs.



### *Why do farmers use Cover Crops?*

**To improve soil fertility:** Cover crops are high in nutrients, therefore can provide extra nutrients in the soil, reducing the need for fertilizer usage.

**To increase organic matter:** Organic matter in soil is very important to farmers. It provides the

living, breathing, filtering part of soil. High crop yields depend on a healthy, organic topsoil.

**To increase carbon storage:** When a farmer increases the soil's organic matter, they also increase the amount of carbon that can be stored, which can offset the rise in carbon dioxide levels in the atmosphere.

**To moderate temperature:** Cover crops moderate temperature by shielding the soil from direct sunlight.

**To help hold soil in place:** Plants in the field help to slow the speed and force of water running down fields, reducing the amount of soil that is lost due to rain events.

**To improve water quality:** With less soil being lost from the field, there is less soil and nutrient loss to rivers and lakes, therefore improving water quality.

**To naturally control pests, weeds, and diseases:** Cover crops provide diversity during the growing season to reduce insects, weeds, and disease. In many cases, this reduces the need for herbicide or pesticide usage.

### *Manitowoc County farmers share their experience:*

As a result of the known benefits from cover cropping, an increasing number of Manitowoc County farmers are shifting gears to incorporate this practice into their cropping systems. Among the numerous producers in Manitowoc County who are making this shift are two who shared their personal experiences:

Dan Meyer, owner and operator of Dan Meyer Farms in Schleswig, has been using a combination of cover crops and no-till practices on his cropland for years and is noticing a difference in his soil and production. Meyer states that, "The fields we have had in no-till for 10 years or longer are now our most productive". Meyer also noted that his soil structure is improving as a result of using cover crops with no-till in the crop rotation: "The more we do no-till and cover crops the better our soil environment becomes," Meyer stated. The improved soil structure on his fields helps to keep soil in place and is most visible during spring storms: "The best time to see the real benefit of

no till and cover crops is after a spring storm," Meyer continued. A wet fall season won't stop Meyer from harvesting either! "We keep harvesting in spite of wet conditions because of great soil structure". Meyer concludes his exciting cover crop and no-till experience by saying: "Every year, we learn a little more about the benefits of no-till and cover crops."

Jay Binversie, owner and operator of Robinway Dairy LLC in Meeme, has been using cover crops and no-till practices for three years. He has been planting barley as a cover crop after an alfalfa crop. Then, following the barley, he planted corn using a no-till method. According to Binversie, "The yields on those fields have been very good". Binversie has noticed abundant life as a result of using cover crops as well. "If you dig up the ground you will see lots of worms," he said. Binversie mentioned that having cover crops in his field has saved him time in spring, "Because we don't have to work and pick stones." He stated he was pleased to see his fields being protected from erosion as a result of this practice.

## Top 10 Farm Safety Tips

With harvest season in full force, take time to be safe! Even during this busy time of year, the smallest things can have an impact on farm safety. Extension Agricultural Safety & Health Specialist John Shutske shares these top 10 farm safety tips for the busy harvest season!

- Buy a rollover protective structure (ROPS) for older tractors. If an approved ROPS is not available, avoid using that tractor or consider trading or selling it through a local dealer.
- Replace all missing power take-off and rotating equipment shields. Shut off power equipment before leaving the operator's station.
- Check that lights, flashers, and reflectors on machines work properly. Always use them when traveling on roadways.
- Replace "slow moving vehicle" emblems that aren't clean and bright.
- Inspect and repair farm machinery before the busy season. A well-maintained machine will operate more efficiently and reduce the chance of an injury.
- Use proper equipment and procedures when hitching and unhitching implements.
- Never enter a manure pit, grain bin, or silo without following confined space entry procedures. The gases and materials in these structures kill farmers every year.
- Ensure that all workers receive specific instructions on their tasks and the machines they are operating. Be sure they read and understand all operational procedures in the owner's manual.
- Take time to learn basic first aid, CPR, and emergency response.
- Do not assign jobs to children unless they are physically, mentally, and legally ready to perform the job safely, follow directions, and can respond to unexpected situations. This may mean waiting until kids are at least 16 years of age.


